The state high school track and field meet and tennis and golf tournaments were held at Emporia on May 14 and 15. The attendance was the largest we have ever had and the entry list was large. The weather was good and altogether it was one of the best athletic carnivals on record.

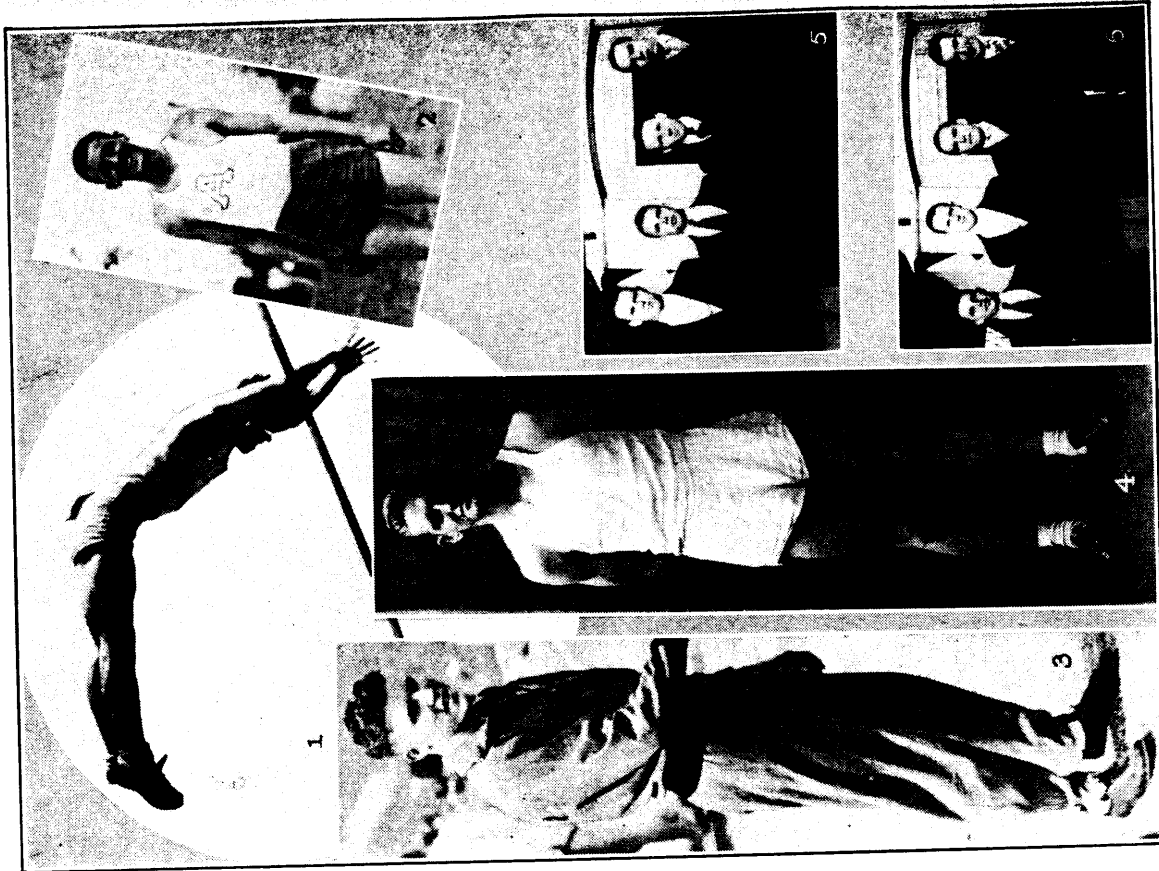
In track and tennis the entrants in the state meets were required to qualify in the nine regional meets held the previous week. The golf tournament was an open affair and approximately 40 boys entered.

Independence won the state track and field title for the second consecutive year. Brooks of Wichita North won the singles title in tennis, with Christner of Topeka taking second place, Swartz and Tucker of Winfield won the tennis doubles championship and second honors were won by Pierce and Swenson of Topeka. John Begert and John Martin of Topeka won the team honors in golf, and Begert was the low medal champion.

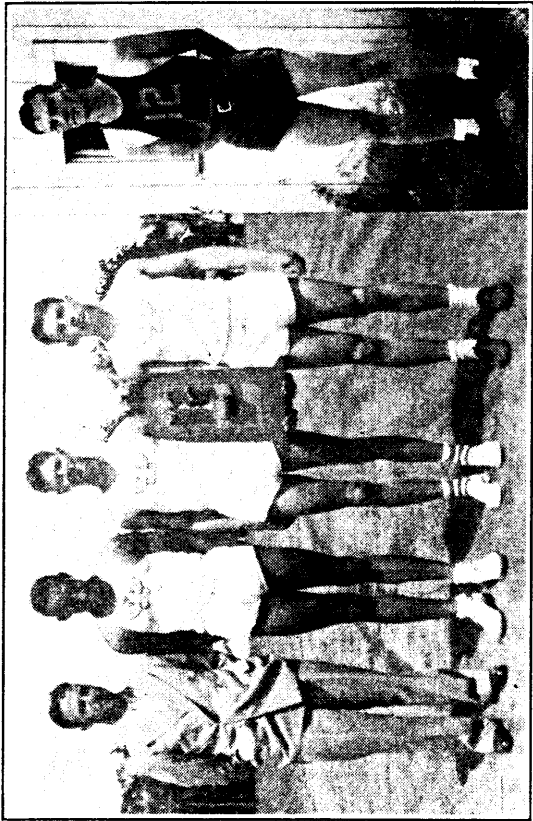

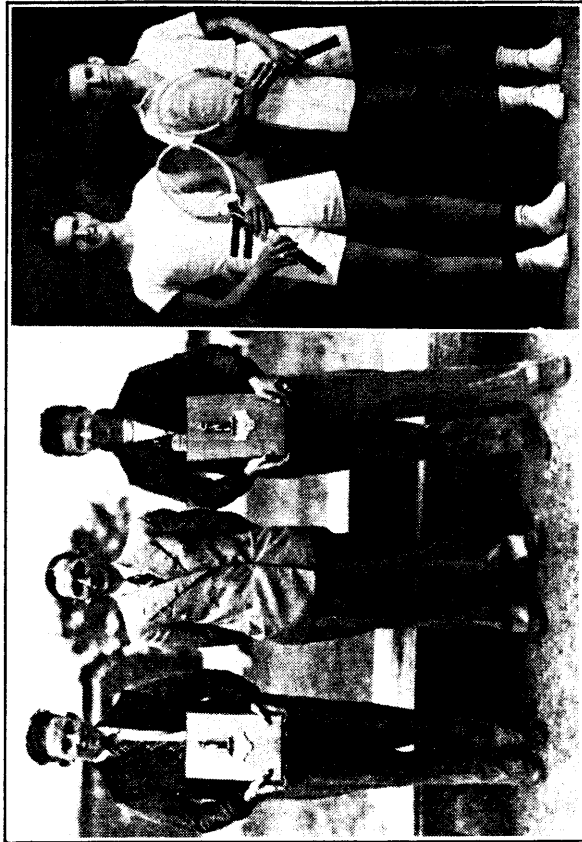
