

WICHITA EAST, KIOWA WIN STATE TRACK TITLES TWO NEW RECORDS ESTABLISHED, ONE TIED; WINFIELD, WICHITA NORTH CAPTURE TENNIS AND GOLF HONORS

Two new records were established and another mark equalled as Wichita East and Kiowa annexed the 1940 state track championships in the annual two-day meet held at Emporia on May 17 and 18.

It was one of the closest Class A battles in the history of the Association. The defending champions from Wichita East retained their crown by placing fourth in the mile relay to nose out Independence, 22 to 21. Topeka was third with 17 points.

Kiowa replaced Mt. Hope as the Class B champion by amassing 26 points. Trousdale was second with 16 while Moran was third with 10.

Records Set In Preliminaries

Friday's preliminaries saw all the record performances as a strong wind during Saturday's finals nullified a trio of record times made over a rain soaked track. Warren Henderson, Moran, skimmed over the low hurdles in 23 seconds flat to wipe out the Class B time of 23.3 seconds made by Montgomery, Conway Springs, in 1935. Norris Fiedler added another Class B mark to the record books when he hurled the discus 143 ft. 5/8 in. for the best throw of the meet in either class, and well beyond the 136 ft. 2 1/2 in. record set by Martin, Rock Creek, last year when the lighter discus was introduced.

One other time was equalled as Harry Pruitt, Independence, skooted over the low hurdle course in 22.6 seconds during Friday's qualifying heats to tie the record set by Ralph Miller, Chanute, in 1937. Record-breaking times which had to be disallowed because of the wind

Saturday were made in the 120-yd. high hurdles, 200-yd. low hurdles and 220-yd. dash.

A record entry list of 58 Class A schools and 109 Class B schools participated in the 1940 meet, an increase of 21 schools over the previous high set last year. Thirty-four Class A schools figured in the scoring, while 53 Class B schools were represented in the point total.
