

HUTCHINSON, BLUE RAPIDS WIN STATE TRACK TITLES

Two New Discus Records Established, Two Marks Disallowed Because of Wind: Class B Division Produces Closest Battle in History

Hutchinson retained its Class A track championship while Blue Rapids won its first state title in nosing out Ashland, defending Class B champion, in the state track and field championships at Emporia on May 15 and 16.

Coach Bill Upson's Salthawks repeated their 1941 victory by outdistancing second place Topeka by $4\frac{3}{4}$ points. Hutchinson tallied 19 points for team honors followed by Topeka with $14\frac{1}{4}$, Wichita East 13, Leavenworth $12\frac{1}{2}$, Wichita North 12, Clay Center $10\frac{1}{2}$, Wellington 10 and Wyandotte 10.

Disqualification of Kiowa's mile relay team for not using the same men which had qualified on Friday caused a shakeup in the Class B standings enabling Blue Rapids to eke out top honors by the scant margin of $\frac{1}{19}$ of a point. Nineteen tied for fifth in the Class B high jump and the fraction of a point won by Ron Estes coupled with 12 turned in by Bill McRae provided the necessary total. Bill Grimes scored all 12 of the Ashland points for runner-up honors.
