

CLEARWATER, WICHITA EAST WIN TRACK TITLES

Two new records were established in the state championship track and field meet at Wichita on May 19 and 20, as Wichita East defended its state title successfully in the Class A division and Clearwater displaced Ashland as the Class B title holder.

Malcomb Smith of Arkansas City set a new Class A 880 yard run record by stepping the distance in 1:57.8 to smash the former record of 1:59.7 held by Blackmore of El Dorado. In the Class B division Karl Ebel of Hillsboro threw the javelin 182 ft. 5½ in.

Wichita East had a well balanced team and scored in a majority of the events to pile up a total of 34½ points for first place in the A division. Ottawa won a clean-cut runner-up decision with a total of 23 points as Coffeyville came through with 17 points for the third position. McClay of Ottawa was high point man with 15 points.

Clearwater squeezed through to a one-point victory over Haven in the Class B division, scoring 23 1/5 points to 22 1/5 for Haven. Sterling won third place by a close shave by scoring 13½ points to Halstead's 13.
