# THREE NEW TITLE WINNERS IN TRACK AND FIELD

## Wichita North, Garden City and Pretty Prairie New Champions. Knight Breaks State Discus Record

With three divisional championships awarded in track and field sports for the first time, Wichita North annexed the AA title, Garden City won the Class A championship and Pretty Prairie romped home with the Class B honors. Bob Knight of Salina put on the only record breaking performance of the meet when he tossed the discus 156 feet, 6½ inches. The meet was held on the Wichita East track and field on May 18 and 19.

The two Wichita high schools, North and East, fought it out for top honors in the AA division but East could not defend its 1944 title against the sterling performances of the north side Indians who annexed a total of 37 points. East piled up 32½ points as Sumner high of Kansas City won third place with a total of 25. Other AA schools in the top scoring were Wyandotte 21, Shawnee Mission 16, Columbus 13 1/6, Wellington 11, Argentine 11, Salina 10.

In the Class A division Garden City is the new champion. The school from southwestern Kansas exhibited a well balanced team that went into the lead early in the meet and was never headed as the boys won a total of 31 points. Marysville was second with 21 1/6 and Hillsboro and Altamont tied for third with 15. Others in the scoring included Russell 13 1/6, Holton 13, Beloit 9, Clay Center 9, Ellinwood 9, Scott City 8½, Anthony 8 1/6, Medicine Lodge 8.

Pretty Prairie edged out Burrton 22 to 19 for top honors in the Class B division as Sterling won third place with 15. Burrton's relay teams kept her in the race while the individual performances of Junior Hess were the deciding factor in Pretty Prairie's victory. Valley Center won 12 points, Oxford 11, Blue Rapids 10, Hugoton 9, Glen Eider 8, School for the Deaf 8.

Individual honors for the meet went to Karl Ebel of Hillsboro who won 15 points with first places in the shot, discus and javelin in Class A.
