NEW TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONS IN EACH CLASS

Topeka Wins AA Title; Ottawa Class A Champion; Leon Annexes B Title

New champions were crowned in all classes at the State Track and Field Meet held in Manhattan on May 14 and 15. In class AA, Topeka replaced Wichita East, Ottawa replaced St. Joseph's of Hays in class A, and Leon dominated the field in class B to dethrone Esbon, the 1947 winner.

Participants took full advantage of pleasant weather to establish five new records and tie two others. In class AA, Maurice Stevens of Topeka set a new record of 22.3 seconds in the low hurdles. Class A competitors dominated the day of record breaking performances by establishing new records in the following events: 220 yd. dash-22.2 seconds by Clayton Campbell of Minneapolis, which tied the existing record; 200 yd. low hurdles-22.5 seconds by Bob Clark of Beloit; Mile Run-4 minutes 32.4 seconds by Elwin Becker of Sts. Peter and Paul (Seneca); Javelin-181 feet 1 7/8 inches by Jim Swim of Marysville; 880 yd. run-2 minutes 00.6 seconds by Jim Widrig of Beloit, which tied the existing record. In class B, Don Smith of Belle Plaine established a new record in the 200 yd. low hurdles with a time of 22.5 seconds. Three marks were not allowed because of a supporting wind at the time these events were run: Class AA 100 yd. dash-9.9 seconds by Bill Baker of Salina; Class AA high hurdles-14.8 seconds by Byron Renner of Hutchinson; Class A high hurdles-14.9 seconds by Hiram Faubion of Phillipsburg.

Topeka had a total of 31 1/2 points to win the AA title, followed by Salina with 22 and Shawnee Mission with 21. Wichita East, because of having an ineligible runner in the 880 relay and mile relay, dropped from second to a tie with Wyandotte for fourth with a total of 19 points. In class A, Ottawa barely nosed out Minneapolis by 1/2 point with a total of 17 1/2 to 17 for Minneapolis. Rosedale was third in class A with 16 points, followed by Beloit with 15. Leon dominated class B with 30 points, second place Trousdale getting 19. Walton had 15 for third and Coldwater 14 for fourth.
