TWO NEW TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONS

Wichita East Repeats As Class AA Champion; Hoisington Annexes Class A Title; Mullinville New Class B Title Holder; New Class B High Hurdle and High Jump Records; New Marks In Class A Broad Jump and Shot Put.

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The Wichita East Blue Aces of Coach Fritz Snodgrass' annexed their eighth track and field title in eleven years in the Class AA division of the state track meet held at Kansas State College, Manhattan, on May 15 and 16. East, stretching a thin squad to the limit, rolled up 29 points to out-distance challenging Shawnee Mission, which had 22½. Haskell took third place honors with 18 points, followed by Coffeyville with 17½, Hutchinson 17, Wyandotte 16 and Topeka 13.

Hoisington took first in four events and a fourth in another for 22 points to win the Class A title for the first time. Larned scored 20 for second, defending champion Stafford took third with 15, followed by Marysville with 14, Garnett 13, and Abilene 12.

Mullinville won a track and field championship for the first time, taking the Class B title with a total of 14 points. All Mullinville points were scored by Melvin Coates, the outstanding individual performer of the meet, with firsts in the high and low hurdles and second in the 220. Coates was the lone record-breaker in the finals on Saturday, setting a new mark of 14.8 in the 120-yard high hurdles. Second-place winner in the Class B was Johnson with 12 points, last year's winner, Arma, was third with 11, followed by Belle Plaine with 9 1/7, and Gardner, Mt. Hope, Macksville and Maize 9.

Two new marks were set in the Class A division on Friday. Jim Blackwell of Larned tossed the shot 52 feet 7/8 inches for a new Class A shot put record; Blaine Hollinger of Russell set a new broad jump record of 22 feet 7 1/8 inches. Bob Sullivan of Hudson set a new Class B high jump mark of 6 feet 3 inches during the Friday afternoon events.

The preliminaries were run off under favorable conditions on Friday but a heavy rain Saturday morning soaked the Kansas State oval to a point where record-breaking was almost an impossibility. Intermittent showers fell during the finals Saturday afternoon.
