Complete details regarding the plan have been mailed to all registered officials. Premium payments should be sent direct to the Security Life and Accident Company, Denver, Colorado.

### Send Cash For Rules Books

When ordering rules books, cash of 25c for each book ordered should be enclosed with the request. This applies especially to any order for less than four books. It will facilitate the handling of these requests if the necessity of billing is eliminated.

# Student Transfer Certificates

Principals are required to use Student Transfer Certificates for all transfer students who intend to take part in any interscholastic activities. The ordinary transcript of grades does not provide all essential information in regard to interschool participation, broken semesters, etc.

It should be noted that students must meet eligibility requirements in all interschool activities.

# Examination For Officials

All registered football and basketball officials are required to take examinations on the rules in each sport.

Copies of the football test have been mailed to all registered officials for that sport. Answer sheets must be sent to Association headquarters not later than October 1. There will be graded and returned.

Cooperation in sending these in early will save much time and will assist in avoiding errors. It will also help in eliminating the necessity of sending additional notices.

# Approval By Both Schools

In selecting officials for football and basketball games schools should make certain that their opponents are in agreement. Both schools are privileged to approve officials before they are selected.

# No Indoor Track Meet Next Spring

Because of a conflict with Easter week-end, there will be no indoor track meet in 1959. Kansas State College officials felt it would not be advisable to hold the meet during Easter vacation since an adequate staff would not be available at that time to conduct the event properly. A college invitational meet is scheduled on March 21 and it is not advisable to hold an indoor meet the first week in April since the dates would conflict with many outdoor meets which are usually held on these dates.

## Eleven Records Set In State Track Meet Wichita East Successfully Defends 1957 Championship; Hugoton and Satanta Win Titles

Wichita East ran up a total of 52/2 points in Kansas

State's sunlit Memorial Stadium to walk off with the Class AA track and field crown. Shawnee Mission was second with 32 points, Topeka third with 1914, followed by McPherson with 16. Wichita North 1412, and Junction City 14.

Hugoton scored all of its points in the field events to nose out a fine Hoisington team 20 13/14 to 20 and win the Class A championship. Hays and Leoti battled it out for third and fourth place honors with 15 and 14 points respectively.

In Class B, Satanta was the surprise winner with 14 1/5 points as pre-meet favorites Lakin and Attica came in second and third with 12 points and 11 points each. A total of 50 teams split up the Class B scoring.

A crowd of approximately 3,500 fans saw eleven records shattered during the two-day meet on May 16 and 17. Headlining the list of record-breaking performances were the 4:20.1 and 4:20.8 mile races by Wichita East's Archie San Romani Jr. and Bill Dotson of Concordia; the 175' 111/2 discus record set by last year's record holder Bill Vernon of Oberlin and the state's best half-mile in history, a 1:55.9, turned in by Bill Stone of Wichita East. Other records were established in the following events: Class AA, Mile Relay-Pittsburg, 3:25.2; Pole Vault-Schmanke, Ottawa, 12'8; Medley Relay-Washington of Bethel, 3:36.8; Class A. Medley Relay-Lincoln, 3:39.4; Class B, Javelin-Walker, Englewood, 199' 11/4. In the preliminaries on Friday, Hoisington set a new Class A mile relay record with a time of 3:27.9 and Lincoln established a new record in the 880 yard relay with a 1:32.2 time.

Hays' Dale Alexander scored all of his team's points by winning the 100, 220 and low hurdles. This was his second straight year of winning the two dashes. Class AA produced three double winners Saturday in Junction City's Charley Smith, Wichita East's Bob Crumpacker and Shawnee Mission's Dave Butts. In Class B, Tom Ferguson of Douglass was the only double winner.


