Another accomplishment of note was set by sophomore Bob Barratti of Wichita North when he won the mile run in 4:17.1.

Mike Reeves led his team to victory, as Concordia scored 31 points to win the Class A title. Haven was second with 26, and Ellinwood third with 22. Reeves won both the high and low hurdles and ran a leg on the winning 880-yard relay team.

Larry Dester of Haven scored a double in winning the 100 and 220-yard dashes.

Concordia finished second last year. The victory is the second, having won the first title in 1962.

Roger Timken, the sprinter-hurdler from Cimarron, was a one-man gang as he accumulated 18 points to give his school its first state championship. He set records in both hurdles with a time of 14.5 in the high and 19.5 in the low hurdles. He won the 220-yard dash in 22.2.

Frontenac finished a close second with 16 points, as Bob Watt provided the greatest assist by scoring second to Timken in both the high and low hurdles, and running in the second-place 880-yard relay team and the fifth-place mile relay team. Johnson was third with 13 points.

Glenn Cunningham Jr. of Leon broke the mile record with a time of 4:22.1. Another outstanding performance was that of Carl Nicholson of Maize, whose time was 1:54.8 in the 880-yard run.

Ford scored the second Class BB state championship by amassing 20 points. The first came in 1964 (Ford was Class B in 1965). Harveyville was a close second with 18, and Scandia third with 14. Jerry Shelly of Ford led his team to victory with a record-setting performance of 1:59.9 in the 880-yard run, and added a 220-yard leg to the record-setting medley relay team.

Rick Chatham of Harveyville matched Timken as a triple winner when he won the 440-yard dash in 51.1, the 220-yard dash in 23 flat, and the broad jump with a record-setting performance of 21 feet, 9 3/4 inches.

Don Siemens of Windom won the mile for the third consecutive year. Don Winters of Preston won the 180-yard low hurdles for the second consecutive year, and broke his record of a year ago by running the low hurdles in 20.0. Rich Raney of Scandia was a double winner, capturing first place in the discus and the shot put events.
